Important Program Notes:

International Baccalaureate (IB): Students enrolled in the IB programme are charged an annual administration fee of \$2,240.

VET Subjects: Students in Years 9–12 who enrol in VET subjects (including VCE, VM, and VPC programs) will incur a materials charge of \$3,032.

Tuition Fee

The tuition fee has been determined after taking into account Federal and State Government grants available to the School. It covers tuition at Preshil and the cost of materials used by students associated with the mandatory aspects of the curriculum, including, but not limited to, the provision of specialist classes, support for inclusive education, classroom materials, the cost of electives, inhouse transport costs and IT related expenses.

Sibling Discounts

Families with more than one child enrolled at the School are eligible for a discount on the tuition fee. The discount structure is:

- Second child – 10% discount
- Third child – 25% discount
- Fourth and subsequent child – 50% discount

Please note: The largest discount will always be applied to the fees for the lowest year level.

Music Lessons

Fees for music lessons in 2027 are as follows:

30-minute lessons: \$1,034 per semester (16 lessons)

45-minute lessons: \$1,504 per semester (16 lessons)

Music charges are billed in advance each semester, at the start of Terms 1 and 3. Once charged, students are committed for the full semester (two terms). Lessons may only be discontinued by providing at least four weeks' written notice to the relevant campus administrator prior to the end of the semester, with termination taking effect from the following semester. Cancellations during term semester are not permitted, and refunds will not be issued.

Camps and Excursions

Compulsory camps and excursions for Years 2–8 are not included in the tuition fee. These costs are now billed separately and will be announced as each camp is planned. Families will receive separate invoices for these activities. Please note that camp fees are non-refundable if a student does not attend, as the school covers all camp costs in advance.

Extra-curricular activities

Additional charges for extracurricular activities such as optional sports, academic competitions and other activities will be billed to the fee account separately.

Application Fee

A non-refundable Application Fee of \$150 (including GST)

Enrolment Fee

A non-refundable and non-transferable Enrolment Fee is due upon acceptance of an enrolment offer: \$1,500 for Primary School and \$2,000 for Secondary School. For families enrolling siblings simultaneously, the maximum enrolment fee per family is capped at \$3,500.

Voluntary Building Fund (tax-deductible)

Families are invited to make a voluntary annual contribution of \$650 to support the School's building program. These contributions are essential to moving our development plans forward. If you would like to participate, a separate invoice will be sent with payment details.

Voluntary Association Fee

This \$20 annual fee grants membership in the legal entity 'Preshil – The Margaret Lyttle Memorial School', including voting rights at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). Your membership matters—parent voices like yours keep our school governance strong and our community connected. Miscellaneous Donations

Donations of \$2 or more to Preshil are tax-deductible under the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1998*.

Payment Options

Preshil offers families the following options for paying school fees:

1. **Annual fees in advance direct to Preshil** - A 2% discount is available for tuition fees paid on or before 11 December 2026.
2. **Regular payments via EdStart** - make regular payments between January and November on a weekly, fortnightly, or monthly basis. The school will pay the cost of providing the EdStart service, ensuring that it remains free for families to use. Families wishing to pay their fees in instalments must visit <https://edstart.com.au/preshil> to set up an Edstart Plus account.

Methods of Payment

The following options are available for the payment of fees:

Payment Terms

By signing the Confirmation of Enrolment Form, parents agree to be jointly and severally liable for all fees and other payments. Any request to vary this agreement must be made in writing. Tuition Fees for 2027 are due 8th January 2027 unless a family has enrolled in a payment plan with EdStart.

Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)

Eligible families can receive support for camps, sports, and excursions through this fund. Check your eligibility at the [DHHS website](#) before contacting the Finance team. Rebates apply only to current Health Care Concession card holders—please email a copy of your card to fees@preshil.vic.edu.au.

Withdrawal or Absentee Charges

If the Principal or the Board cancels the enrolment of a Student and provided that the cancellation is not due to the failure to pay fees and levies, there will be no further charges levied. The school will calculate a refund based on the pro rata portion of the year remaining, tuition and other fees due, and payments received.

In addition to the above, one full school terms' notice in writing is required to be given prior to the student's intended withdrawal from the School. Otherwise, a term's fees may be payable in lieu of the required notice. Written notice is to be addressed to the Principal and supplied to the Admissions Manager (admissions@preshil.vic.edu.au).

No proportion of the current term's fees will be reimbursed if a student leaves the Preshil part way through the term.

Leave of Absence

Should a student intending to return to the School be absent for a term or more (max. of 4 terms), \$1,000 per term will be required to hold a place open. The Principal should be advised, in writing, one term in advance of the intended absence. If the absence is to be greater than two terms, an appointment should be made with the Principal to discuss place availability.

Family background information

Preshil collects various family background information that is required to fulfil legal obligations under the Australian Education Act 2013 and the Victorian Schools Funding Agreement. Parents and guardians are responsible for the ongoing currency and accuracy of student and family information that is held by the School including residential addresses, parent occupation details, and medical details.

Parents or guardians may update the family and student information by phone or in writing to the respective campus administrators.

Insurance

Preshil maintains student accident insurance cover which includes a level of protection for students worldwide 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, against accidental bodily injury, subject to certain exclusions. The School strongly recommends that parents assess this

cover in light of their own insurance requirements. A Schedule of Events and Compensation is available on request from the Chief Operating Officer to enable review of the benefits available.

If a child is injured during the year and a parent needs to make a claim on the student insurance policy, they should contact the Chief Operating Officer on 9817 6135.
